The "Fête des Vignerons" is unique in its kind and takes place once per generation in Vevey, Switzerland. The festival is organised by the 'Confrérie des Vignerons' since the 18th century and is a celebration of the regional traditions, shown with a play as well modern as magnificent. Since 1st December 2016 it is part of the UNESCO World Heritage and is a witness of the winegrower's identity, their knowledge and the vineyards of Lavaux (UNESCO) and Chablais Vaudois.

This will take place from July 18 – August 11, 2019.



Situated between Lausanne and Chillon Castle alongside Lake Geneva, Lavaux is one of the most beautiful parts of Switzerland, with its man-made vineyard terraces listed as a UNESCO world heritage site. The area is equally known for its walks, villages and, of course, its wines.
